

Use safe and secure practices when working with digital systems

Overview This standard is about protecting hardware, software and the data within an IT system against theft, malfunction and unauthorised access.

It involves staying safe online, reporting any safety issues and following guidelines about the use of IT. It includes using unique passwords, running virus protection software and backup systems; also protecting digital devices and printed information.

## **Performance criteria**

- 2. run security software as required to protect digital systems from viruses and malware
- 3. maintain secure systems by using unique and secure PINs and passwords
- 4. follow secure practices to protect sensitive information online in line with organisational guidelines
- 5. conduct online transactions in line with organisational guidelines
- 6. take precautions in line with organisational data protection policies to protect against loss or theft of mobile devices and printed information
- 7. comply with laws, regulations and organisational safety and security practices for using digital systems

- 5. risks to user safety and privacy when working online
- 6. security precautions that need to be addressed when connecting to the internet
- 7. how to identify secure internet sites
- 8. the need for safety and security practices when working online
- 9. the concept of password strength
- 10. the importance of organisational guidelines and policies for aspects of digital security and the implications of breaches of security
- 11. the use of system-generated passwords and password keepers
- 12. risks associated with downloading software
