Load and unload vehicles on to and from vehicle transporters



Overview

This unit defines the national standard of occupational competence for loading and unloading vehicles on to and from vehicle transporters. These vehicles would have been identified as being parked in contravention of parking regulations. This unit therefore sets the standard for you to: -

1. Prepare to load vehicles on to a transporter (Element PKC 10.1)
2. Load vehicles on to a transporter (Element PKC 10.2)
3. Unload vehicles from a transporter (Element PKC 10.3)

You should be able to correctly identify vehicles that have been parked in contravention of current regulations and that are to be transported. You must be able to manoeuvre the transporter into a suitable and safe position ready to load vehicles, and use loading and gripping equipment safely. Similarly when you unload vehicles, you must make sure the transporter is in a safe and secure position ready to unload vehicles into the required location.

When preparing to load, loading and unloading vehicles, you must follow the relevant health and safety requirements, as well as take care to maintain the condition of the vehicles that are transported.

Performance criteria

You must be able to:

Prepare to load vehicles on to a transporter

- P1 correctly identify the **vehicles** that contravene parking regulations and that are to be transported
- P2 manoeuvre the transporter in to a safe position in relation to the vehicle you are to load
- P3 make sure the transporter is stabilized and secure, always applying safe working practices
- P4 make sure all **loading and gripping devices and equipment** are secured to vehicles in line with your organisation's policies, procedures and safe working practices
- P5 complete vehicle condition reports and take supporting photographs
- P6 complete pre-lifting checks following instructions and in line with your organisation's policies and procedures
- P7 notify the appropriate person if you have difficulty or have to abort loading a vehicle
- P8 follow health and safety requirements while you prepare to load vehicles

Load vehicles on to a transporter

- P9 load **vehicles** on to a transporter only when it is safe to do so
- P10 use the appropriate and approved methods and **equipment** to load vehicles
- P11 make sure vehicles are secured on the transporter before moving off
- P12 notify the appropriate person that vehicle is on route to pound
- P13 take care to maintain the condition of vehicles throughout the loading and transporting operation
- P14 transport and deliver vehicles to the required destination following instructions and in line with your organisation's policies and procedures
- P15 notify the appropriate person if you have difficulty or have to abort loading a vehicle
- P16 follow health and safety requirements while you load and transport vehicles

Unload vehicles from a transporter

- P17 manoeuvre the transporter in to a safe position in relation to where you are to unload the **vehicle**
- P18 make sure the transporter is stabilized and secure, applying safe working practices
- P19 use the appropriate and approved methods and **equipment** to unload vehicles
- P20 unload vehicles into the required suitable place following instructions

- P21 stow equipment away safely and securely after unloading vehicles
- P22 check the condition of vehicles after unloading and report any damage in line with your organisation's policies and procedures

- P23 complete the handover of vehicles to the appropriate persons in line with your organisation's policies and procedures follow health and safety requirements while you unload vehicles
