Assess the incident

Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 evaluate the available information and instructions and taken the appropriate action
 - P2 collect further information by observation, assessment of alarm panels, audible warnings and verbal reports (time permitting)
 - P3 identify explosions, fires, well control incidents, helicopter incidents and evaluated the incidents current and feasible extent from minor to major implications
 - P4 estimate the time available to tackle the incident in accordance with procedures
 - P5 evaluate the pre-formed plans for their suitability to deal with the incident in the immediate, short, medium and longer term timescales
 - P6 determine alternative courses of action in accordance with procedures for action to be taken in the absence of pre-formed plans
 - P7 confirm the priorities as fire team protection, saving life, damage limitation, passive fire protection and the potential for escalation with the appropriate people in accordance with procedures
 - P8 make the initial selection of a pre-formed plan and notified the appropriate people
 - P9 ensure the means and resources required to execute the plan including personnel availability and readiness, priorities, tasks, pre-planned lines of communication and equipment location is confirmed, with the appropriate people in a timely manner and in accordance with the procedures
 - P10 confirm the objectives and priorities as fire team protection, saving life, damage limitation, passive fire protection and the potential for escalation with the appropriate people in accordance with procedures
 - P11 identify the personnel and equipment required to contain the incident and confirmed the availability with the appropriate people
 - P12 establish the likely response times to activate equipment and personnel to contain the incident and conveyed this information to the appropriate people
 - P13 establish priorities to deal with the incident in accordance with procedures
 - P14 set up and establish lines of communication using personal radios, the telephone and PA system and verbal methods
 - P15 review all alternatives with the appropriate people and selected the best option in accordance with procedures
