Overview

- P3 followed approved **emergency procedures** in the event of spillage or contamination occurring
- P4 ensured a responsible person verifies that areas and items are clean
- P5 placed waste materials in designated containers for safe disposal
- P6 worked safely in accordance with operational requirements and associated **Safe Systems of Work**

Restore The Worksite

You must be able to:

- P7 made **unused materials** safe and secure
- P8 transferred materials and equipment safely and without damage, to the appropriate **storage area**
- P9 transferred and handled disposable **waste material**
- P10 cleaned and dismantled equipment
- P11 reinstated the work-site to its original state
- P12 worked safely in accordance with operational requirements and associated **Safe Systems of Work**

- 1 **Methods** may include water jetting, degreasing, industrial vacuuming, washing
- 2 **Emergency procedures** must include following specified procedures i.e. COSHH, Health and Safety, first aid, drills, signals
- 3 **Safe Systems of Work** must include processes or systems that incorporate Hazard Identification, Risk Assessment, Permit to Work and any other associated systems
- 4 **Unused materials** may include degreasers, detergents, other chemicals
- 5 **Storage Areas** must include designated storage areas, containers
- 6 **Waste Materials** may include residuals, contaminants, general waste, toxic/hazardous, radioactive
