Prepare for packaging testing or sampling operations



Overview

To perform competently, you will need to demonstrate that you can operate in a range of conditions. You will need to demonstrate therefore that you can deal effectively with the following:

- 1 resources in terms of materials, personal protective equipment, and utilities
- 2 safe practices relating to personal protective equipment, safe materials handling, safe lifting and moving techniques, disposal and storage
- 3 checks on equipment of calibration, serviceability, cleanliness and preparation
- 4 the immediate environment, operations, people and the conditions under which the test is to be conducted and/or the sample taken

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Performance criteria

You must be able to:

- P1 use the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- P2 check that the correct documentation is available before testing or sampling commences
- P3 check that all the required resources are available and have been correctly prepared in accordance with quality standards and legal requirements
- P4 ensure that testing/sampling equipment is in a serviceable condition and that it has been calibrated correctly
- P5 identify unserviceable equipment and report it following agreed standard operating procedures
- P6 confirm the relevant controlled conditions for testing or sampling
- P7 follow all safety, health and environmental requirements

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Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 which Personnel Protective Equipment (PPE) is appropriate and why
- K2 the documentation that should be completed and the importance of completing it correctly
- K3 how to ensure fitness for purpose and serviceability of equipment
- K4 the precise specification for calibration and which checks should be made
- K5 which resources are needed
- K6 the requirements of the environment for preparation and testing or sampling
- K7 the expected standards of serviceability of testing/sampling equipment
- K8 how to report defective equipment
- K9 the importance of controlled conditions
- K10 the external influences which might give rise to variations
- K11 the conditions of time, recording systems and cleanliness
- K12 the purpose of testing or sampling
