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### Overview

To perform competently, you will need to demonstrate that you can operate in a range of conditions. You will need to demonstrate therefore that you can deal effectively with the following:

- 1 resources in terms of materials, personal protective equipment, and utilities
- 2 safe practices relating to personal protective equipment, safe materials handling, safe lifting and moving techniques, disposal and storage
- 3 the immediate environment, operations, people and the conditions under which the test is conducted and/or the sample taken
- 4 information covering sample identification test results, calculations and data processing and the conditions of tests

For example, you could conduct tests for challenge testing of security equipment, colour, weight, fit with mating components, environmental requirements, specific quality requirements and etc.

You might be taking samples for reference, testing, quality and etc.
