Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 use the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and/or product-specific equipment/clothing
 - P2 check that the specified services and equipment are available and ready for use
 - P3 check that all specified products and materials are available in the required quantity and at the correct time
 - P4 identify correctly all products and materials against documentation
 - P5 ensure that the work area is suitably prepared and is ready for use
 - P6 complete pre start-up checks according to the procedure
 - P7 identify and deal with problems according to the procedure

Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 which Personnel Protective Equipment (PPE) is appropriate and why
- K2 any specialised protective equipment or clothing needed for the product and its use
- K3 how to confirm line clearance
- K4 which pieces of equipment and materials are needed and are in place
- K5 the critical factors affecting product quality (e.g. temperature, humidity etc.)
- K6 any specific product handling requirements and sources of information (e.g. hazard data sheets)
- K7 how to verify against the documentation that the product and materials are correct
- K8 how to complete product security/integrity checks
- K9 the authorised adjustment that can be made during the packaging run
- K10 which documents to obtain and when
- K11 the acceptable time limits for the completion of tasks
- K12 the procedure for reporting problems
- K13 the methods for dealing with problems
