Overview

To perform competently, you will need to show that you can operate in a range of conditions. You will need to demonstrate therefore that you can deal effectively with the following:

- 1 incidents, hazardous conditions or emergencies (actual or near misses) resulting from a fire, an injured person, a major plant or similar failure
- 2 procedures relating to quality standards, legal requirements and departmental emergency procedures
- 3 alarms to be raised by mechanical/electronic means, and by notifying someone

This unit deals with the following:

- 1 Identify incidents, hazardous conditions or emergencies
- 2 Take immediate action in response to incidents, hazardous conditions or emergencies

Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 what the health and safety implications might be for each type of risk
- K2 procedures for reporting and dealing with such situations
- K3 which types of alarm you should use for which circumstances
- K4 the possible consequences of not acting immediately
- K5 the general principles of health and safety working practices and regulatory requirements
- K6 what the problem is and whom it might affect
- K7 what the longer term consequences might be if the situation is not dealt with immediately
- K8 the organisation's systems and procedures for dealing with incidents and emergencies
- K9 safe route to designated assembly points
- K10 how your plan is designed to minimise risks to individuals and loss of time
- K11 what alternative courses of action are open to you
- K12 why you might need to adapt your actions
- K13 how you would communicate with others and coordinate their actions
- K14 the accident reporting procedures
