Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 how to access and interpret (to include written, oral, numerical) relevant information (e.g. publications, approved codes of practice, organisational regulations and policies, statutory notices, contracts within and external to the organisation)
- K2 how to deal with insufficient, inadequate information (to include written, oral, numerical)
- K3 the impact of inter-related operational activities
- K4 how to prepare a report detailing conclusions and the rationale for those decisions
- K5 that you understand the measures and their implementation
- K6 how to assess the fitness for purpose of the measures
- K7 how to deal with requests for further detailed information
- K8 how to maintain the resources (to include safety equipment, fire protection equipment, life saving equipment, safe systems of work, practices and procedures)
- K9 the availability and use of resources
- K10 the limits of your own responsibility
- K11 how to identify weak measures and how to resolve them
