Frame sustainable development policies in planning and conservation



Overview

This unit is about evaluating the effectiveness of planning, conservation and development strategies by measuring performance against objectives, and targets and proposals.

As part of the review process you will need to identify areas where improvements are needed, evaluate different methods for improvement and consult on the options available and recommend them to decision makers.

You will also need to present a final draft plan to decision makers and submit final draft plan as part of adoption process.

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Performance criteria

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You must be able to:

- P1 collate and organise all relevant information regarding agreed **strategies** in order to frame planning, conservation and development **policy**
- P2 engage with decision makers of organisation to obtain a strategic steer on **policy** direction
- P3 verify the **key features** of the agreed **strategy** through stakeholder engagement
- P4 identify and research any additional information required to complete the development of planning, conservation and development **policies**
- P5 analyse all available information to identify the key features of the planning, conservation and development **policy** and their deliverability
- P6 present the case for the **policy** to decision makers at the appropriate level of accountability
- P7 take account of feedback from decision makers and revise and finalise the planning, conservation and development **policy** accordingly
- P8 develop an implementation plan which includes all the relevant **constraints and factors**

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You need to know and understand:

- K2 how and why to verify the key features of the agreed **strategy** through consultation with stakeholders (analysis)
- K3 how to engage with decision makers of your organisation to obtain a strategic steer on **policy** direction (application)
- K4 what to identify as any additional information required to complete the development of planning, conservation and development **policies** (understand)
- K5 how and why to research any additional information required to complete the development of planning, conservation and development **policies** (analysis)
- K6 how and why to analyse all available information to identify the key features of the planning conservation and development policy (analysis)
- K7 how to present the case for the **policy** to decision makers at the appropriate level of accountability (application)
- K8 how to revise the planning, conservation and development **policy** accordingly (application)
- K9 how to take account of feedback from decision makers and revise and finalise the planning, conservation and development **policy** accordingly (synthesis)
- K10 how and why to finalise the planning, conservation and development **policy** (evaluation)
- K11 how and why to develop an implementation plan which includes all the relevant **constraints and factors** (synthesis)
