Prepare goods and materials for despatch



Overview

This standard covers the skills and knowledge needed to prepare goods and materials for despatch.

This covers establishing customer requirements and preparing them into a condition ready for despatch.

This standard is for you if you work in food and drink operations and the associated supply operations and are involved in preparing and assembling goods and materials for despatch.

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Performance criteria

You must be able to:

Prepare to assemble goods and materials for despatch

- 1. prepare according to the legal or regulatory requirements, the organisational health and safety, hygiene and environmental standards and instructions
- 2. obtain packing and despatch documentation for individual customers
- 3. prepare work area into a condition suitable for order preparation
- 4. obtain materials and resources to support the creation of orders
- 5. identify locations of selected items
- 6. take effective action in response to operating problems
- 7. maintain effective communication

Assemble and prepare goods and materials for despatch

- 8. operate to the legal or regulatory requirements, the organisational health and safety, hygiene and environmental standards and instructions
- 9. select and assemble the correct goods to match despatch documentation
- 10. handle products in a manner which maintains their quality and condition
- 11. check that the prepared consignment matches the despatch instructions
- 12. secure assembled order ready for despatch
- 13. complete and label orders according to specification
- 14. maintain condition of work area throughout process
- identify and report any discrepancies or difficulties with preparing consignments
- 16. take effective action in response to operating problems

Finish order preparation

- 17. finish according to the legal or regulatory requirements, the organisational health and safety, hygiene and environmental standards and instructions
- 18. dispose of waste according to organisational procedures
- 19. make equipment and work area ready for future use, after the completion of the process
- 20. maintain effective communication
- 21. complete all necessary documentation according to company procedures





Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- 1. what the legal or regulatory requirements, the organisational health and safety, hygiene and environmental standards and instructions are and what may happen if they are not followed
- 2. the facilities required to despatch food and drink products
- 3. how to obtain and interpret packing and despatch documentation
- 4. how to identify product
- 5. how to prepare products for despatch
- 6. the different types of packaging used for despatch
- 7. how to monitor and assess the quality of packaging
- 8. how to recognise the quality of product
- how to assemble orders so that the quality of goods and materials is maintained
- 10. how to handle product to maintain condition and quality
- 11. how to assess the condition of packing materials
- 12. labelling and despatch instructions
- 13. how to check consignment notes against instructions
- 14. how to deal with order discrepancies
- 15. what action to take when the process specification is not met
- 16. how to dispose of waste in accordance with legal and organisational regualtions and why it is important to do so
- 17. the limits of your own authority and competence and why it is important to work within those limits
- 18. what recording, reporting and communication is needed, how to carry this out and the reasons why it is important to do so



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
