
Overview

This standard is about cleaning the stables and yard under the direction of a supervisor. Cleaning will include skip out, full muck out, disinfection, main yard area, muck heap, feed room, hay/straw, barn and tack room.

You will need to be fully aware of the importance of health and safety in connection with this work

Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 Tie the horse up safely and securely
 - P2 Prepare the equipment and bedding as instructed
 - P3 Clean stables and dispose of waste according to instructions
 - P4 Replace and store equipment according to instructions
 - P5 Check the water supply for the horse is clean
 - P6 Keep the yard clean and maintain the muck area in accordance with instructions
 - P7 Clean surface drains to ensure the free flow of excess water
 - P8 Identify and report faults and defects immediately to the appropriate person
 - P9 Maintain the health and safety of horses, self and others during the work.

- K3 Your responsibilities under animal health and welfare and health and safety legislation and codes of practice
- K4 How to handle and tie horses up safely and securely
- K5 Correct methods for disposal of waste
- K6 The types, correct use and storage of equipment used in cleaning stables
- K7 The correct use of cleaning materials and legislative requirements
- K8 Types of hazards which may be present in the stable and yard and how these should be removed or controlled
- K9 Reasons for keeping yard and surrounding areas free from hazards
- K10 Hygiene requirements for horses, self and others
- K11 Health and safety implications associated with drains and muck heaps
- K12 To whom faults and defects should be reported.
