criteria

You must be able to:	P1	select size standards that are appropriate for the country, market and custor	mer
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- P2 ensure the size standards match the gender and age profile of the end customer
- P3 identify key body landmark measurements for specified product types
- P4 create a set of master block patterns that contain all relevant markings and sizing
- P5 integrate sizing and material characteristics into block patterns
- P6 label patterns with required information
- P7 store block patterns where they are easily accessible
- P8 complete appropriate records and documents
- P9 communicate effectively with colleagues and customers
- P10 identify problems and resolve issues within limits of your own responsibility
- P11 report problems outside area of responsibility to the appropriate person
- P12 work to legal requirements, standards and regulations, policies, procedures and professional codes
