
Overview

This Standard involves finding out about the photo imaging industry in the UK, identifying the various different inter-related sectors of which it is made up, and understanding how changing technologies and media convergence are blurring the distinctions between these sectors.

It is about understanding the key skills needed by those working in photo imaging, and developing your own visual literacy - learning the language and conventions of photography and understanding the many purposes for which photo images are used.

It also involves developing an appreciation of the wide range of employment and business opportunities in photo imaging, and how different roles fit into the overall picture.
