
Overview

"This standard is about implementing, maintaining and reviewing systems for the health, safety, welfare, wellbeing and environmental protection of the workplace.

Ensuring personnel are aware of their health, safety and environmental responsibilities and ensuring personnel have access to the necessary equipment and resources for welfare, safe, healthy and an environmentally responsible work place in accordance with current organisational requirements which are equal to or exceed current statutory and legislative requirements

This standard is for people working in the occupational area of construction site supervision which is defined as the supervision of multiple construction trades and disciplines and can be used by operatives, supervisors and managers"
