

Overview

This standard identifies the requirements when leading the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals. This includes promoting the housing preferences and needs of individuals and negotiating and agreeing housing provision with and for them.

Performance criteria

You must be able to:

1. identify and agree the roles and responsibilities of yourself and others to promote housing opportunities for individuals
2. lead the provision of information on the benefits of housing opportunities and the impact of discrimination, oppression and social exclusion on individuals
3. work in collaboration with others who provide housing opportunities to identify and confirm what they can offer, the opportunities they can provide, and reasonable restrictions or adjustments required
4. empower others to work in partnership with individuals to review and identify available housing options to meet their preferences and needs
5. provide opportunities for individuals and others to evaluate the potential benefits and identify and address challenges to housing options
6. take responsibility to ensure risk assessments are reviewed or completed for selected housing options
7. work in collaboration with others to support individuals to secure and access housing opportunities
8. ensure systems are in place to support the evaluation of the process of accessing housing opportunities
9. ensure feedback is reviewed, identifying good practice and address any changes
10. complete records and reports required for leading the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals
11. reflect on how you carried out your roles and responsibilities to lead the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals

Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

1. the role which housing opportunities have on the wellbeing of individuals
2. the impact of exclusion, societal and structural oppression on housing opportunities for individuals
3. national and local housing opportunities, how to access them and the benefits to individuals and society
4. how to lead on the application of trauma informed principles when promoting housing opportunities for individuals
5. how to use evidence-based research to lead the promotion of housing opportunities
6. how to use digital tools and devices to promote housing opportunities
7. methods to present information to encourage interest in housing opportunities
8. how to lead on dignity, kindness and compassion when promoting housing opportunities for individuals
9. how to support emotional regulation when promoting housing opportunities
10. how to empower others to identify and address the benefits and challenges of accessing housing opportunities for individuals
11. the influence of neurodivergence and additional needs on the housing opportunities provided
12. how to support others to consider the influence of culture and background on selection of housing opportunities
13. how to support others to assess risk to individuals when accessing housing opportunities, and support positive risk taking
14. the records and reports required when leading the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals
15. theories relevant to leading the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals
16. the relevant legal requirements, standards of practice, frameworks and guidance for leading the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals
17. the workplace requirements on equality, diversity, inclusion, and rights when leading the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals
18. how to work in partnership with others to lead the promotion of housing opportunities for individuals
19. how your personal experiences and unconscious bias may impact when
