- 5. check all materials required are to specification and free from faults following standard operating procedures
- 6. place borders around mattresses to specification following standard operating procedures
- 7. insert backing/wadding to specification following standard operating procedures
- 8. check border is square, true and central and meets specification following standard operating procedures
- 9. gauge borders and mark for stitching to specification following standard operating procedures
- stitch borders to specification following standard operating procedures
- 11. carry out quality checks to specification following standard operating procedures
- 12. correct any faults following standard operating procedures
- 13. pass onto next stage following standard operating procedures

- 7. how to check borders are square, true and central and why this is important
- 8. how to gauge borders and mark for stitching
- 9. how to stitch and knot
- 10. quality checks and why these are important
- 11. common faults and the process for correcting these
